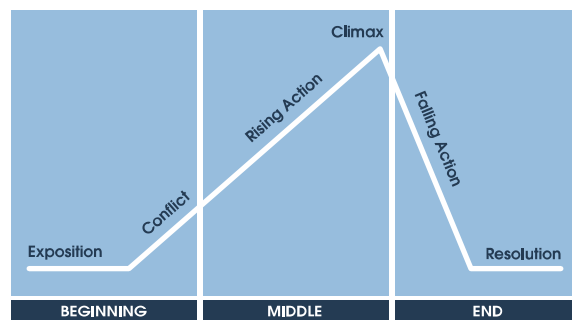


# Guided Notes for Plot Diagram
