







Plot Diagram Assignment with StoryboardThat.com

Directions: You will use Storyboardthat.com to depict the plot from a story you have read. This should be completed by using 6 cells and include elements like thought and word bubbles to show dialogue. For this, you will be required to use your book for reference, recall information, and use your creativity! Your final storyboard can be in any digital format or can be printed out. Both the digital and hard copy should showcase your time and effort.

Please see the example and the criteria for detailed information.

Criteria:

- Minimum 6 storyboard cells.
- Each cell should contain one or more of the following: dialogue, a thought cloud, or sound effect.
- Each cell should visually and accurately represent the events that took place in the story.
- Characters should be consistently and accurately used.
- Important quotes or sayings should be placed in thought or text bubbles - this should look neat and not over crowd the scene.
- A title cell should be used to show the stage of the plot diagram.
- A description box should be used below each cell to explain the stage as it occurs in the story.
- Creativity and ingenuity should be visible!
